1. Caregivers as Partners Kick-Off sessions

DEBRIEF

- Lots of feedback about how impactful the sessions were especially the foster parent panel.
- Had approximately 200 people attend (incl. ~30 at Hotline dept meeting)
- Surveys were filled out and are now being collated.
- Will resurvey same attendees via survey monkey in 90 days and again in 180 to see if there is any change.

HOW TO KEEP THE MOMENTUM GOING

- Ask Sr. Mgr to team with sup and worker who attended
- Use Denise's powerpoint (with her notes) at their next department meeting. Cover high points of presentation and talk about personal experience. Could be maybe a 15 to 20 minute presentation.
- Ask staff during this time to start formulating and turning in questions in advance of a foster parent panel at their next dept meeting. This will contribute to more of a conversation when we bring in a foster parent panel.
- Give Sr. Mgrs. Separate Role Cards to hand out and ask staff to put on their bulletin boards
- **Pair each sr mgr with a QPI leader sr mgr to offer assistance for presentation**

2. Outcome Measures Reminders

a. Indicators

- i. Decrease number of lateral moves
 1. Can get numbers from JMc
